Here is my controller method which I'm using for validating the login request. public function login() { \$input = Input::all(); \$rules = array( 'email'=>'required|email', 'password'=>'required' ); \$validation = Validator::make(\$input,\$rules); if(\$validation->fails()) { return Redirect::to('/login'); } else { // login for success } } what should I do for store values which I want to use as authenticated values. A: You need to use Auth to store something in session and do something else depending on logged in/out status. Something like this maybe: Route::get('/test', function () { if (Auth::check()) { // Logged in so do something that's authenticated } else { // Logged out so something that
